Steel potential

Who would have thought that a piece of scrap metal could be transformed into a thing of beauty? Evidently, French artist Edouard Martinet.

Aged 10, Martinet was inspired by his teacher's obsession for insects, and has since spent the last 40 years fascinated by the elegance of small creatures. The exhibition **Edouard Martinet (to 31 Jan)** at Sladmore Contemporary reveals these elegant, delicate creatures, including insects, birds and fish, made from bits of cast off junk he collected from flea markets and car boot sales.

Rather than weld the delicate pieces together, which would make them uniformly precise, Martinet chooses to use screws, which act like joints, and thus gives his creatures a certain life and character.
